

The Marilyn Horne Foundation just completed a big week with a festival of seven events at Carnegie Hal, launched Sunday, January 18 in a star-studded gala in Stern Auditorium to celebrate both Marilyn's Diamond Birthday and the 15th Anniversary of the Foundation.

The gala, hosted by Frederica von Stade and Samuel Ramey, presented songs and arias from Marilyn's 50+ year career, performed by contralto Meredith Arwady, sopranos Nicole Cabell and Karita Mattila, counter tenor David Daniels; mezzo sopranos Joyce DiDonato, Susan Graham, and Dolora Zajick; vocalist Isabel Leonard; tenors Piotr Beczala and Bruce Sledge: baritones Thomas Hampson, Dmitri Hvorostovsky, and Lester Lynch; bass-baritones James Morris and Thomas Quasthoff; and pianist William Bolcom, Warren Jones, Martin Katz, Carrie Ann Matheson and Brian Zeger.
